Sacraments

Baptism ~ The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated on the fourth Sunday of each month. Please call the Parish Office to make an appointment. A baptism preparation class will be held on the second Wednesday or fourth Saturday of each month in the Church. Attendance at this class is required by the parents and godparents of the child to be baptized.

Marriage~ Arrangements must be made seven (7) months prior to the wedding date. Please call the rectory office to make an appointment with a priest to discuss your marriage plans.

RCIA ~Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults. For those who are interested in becoming Catholic or if you have not received all of the sacraments of initiation please contact Fr. Cox, Fr. Franklin Ezeroah to inquire about our ongoing RCIA program.

From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Parishioners,

Today's gospel depicts this poor widow, who gave just two small coins to contribute to the treasury. Jesus acknowledges this woman as an example of tremendous faith, giving the little that she had to fulfill her duty. With only two small coins amounting to a few cents, this woman gave more than the other wealthy people who contributed from their surplus. The Lord is showing us that no matter what we may have, he wants us to give ourselves completely to him. We are the Lords, and we belong to him. We pray every day that our lives will forever and always be rooted in him. Jesus reminds us that we don't need places of honor or accolades, but only that we give of ourselves for the honor and glory of God.

Feast of St. Martin de Porres

Next Sunday, November 14, we will commemorate as a parish community the feast of our patron, St. Martin de Porres. As is the custom, only one Mass will be celebrated next Sunday at 10:30AM which will be held at Our Lady of Victory Church. Immediately following the Mass there will be a light reception in McGuinness Hall. We are asking for donations of breakfast food and beverages. This Mass will take place on Sunday, November 21 at Our Lady of Victory Church beginning at 1:00PM. All are welcomed to pray with us as we commemorate Black Catholic History Month.



What would a bad steward do?




